All monies raised from the sale are invested in Bolado Park. The Heritage Foundation pays for the animal and all related expenses. The winning applicant becomes the only finalist for a \$1,000 college scholarship and receives a commemorative buckle. The scholarship is awarded during their senior year of high school, subject to applicant completing the following:

- Must be responsible for the care of the Heritage Animal
- Required to attend and speak at various community events, 4-H club meetings and FFA Chapter meetings to promote the Heritage Foundation and the use of Buyer Certificates
- Maintain communication about animal, events and outreach with Scholarship Committee Chairperson
- Comply with and adhere to the Heritage Livestock Animal Agreement and Scholarship Guidelines

Recipient Terms and Conditions

As Recipient of the San Benito County Heritage Scholarship Award, I agree to the following Terms and Conditions:

1. Represent the Heritage Foundation and is be responsible for the care of the Heritage Livestock Animal.
2. Must be a least a Junior or Senior in high school (during 2024 Fair) with a minimum 3.0 GPA and reside within San Benito County to apply.
3. Have the animal in my possession 60 days prior to the show.
4. Be eligible to exhibit in the Livestock Project at the San Benito County Fair.
5. Feed and fit my animal to the best of my ability.
6. Follow a feeding and fitting program recommended or approved by my 4-H leader or FFA advisor.
7. Provide transportation for the animal from the selected breeder to my location.
8. Transport the animal from my location to the San Benito County fairgrounds for the mandatory weigh-in.
9. Exhibit this animal at the San Benito County Fair at the conclusion of the San Benito County Livestock Auction.
10. **Not** exhibit the Heritage Livestock Animal in any fair competition during the San Benito County Fair or any other county fair as the Heritage Animal is a “non-compete” animal.
11. Write thank you notes as needed
12. Communicate with the Heritage Foundation Scholarship Committee Chairperson at least weekly on how the animal is progressing and any problems or concerns you might have. The Heritage Hog Committee Chairperson is currently:

SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

The Heritage Animal Scholarship Recipient automatically becomes the only Scholarship Applicant.

The Applicant must be at least a Junior or Senior (at Fair) and becomes eligible as a Senior in high school and must show proof of residency in San Benito County.

The Applicant must provide evidence that he or she currently maintains a minimum 3.0 GPA while in high school. A copy of the high school transcript is required.

The Applicant must show proof of enrollment in a two or four-year College, University, or Technical School at the end of their senior year of high school. If they are not accepted or choose not to attend an institution of higher learning the scholarship award will be rescinded and becomes the property of the San Benito County Heritage Foundation.

A review of adherence to the Heritage Animal Scholarship requirements will be conducted by a Scholarship Committee of not less than three Board Members.

The Scholarship Committee or its assignees shall at its option conduct an interview with the Scholarship Applicant.

If through no fault of their own the Scholarship Applicant (due to medical, emotional, family, or financial circumstances) is unable to attend college after their senior year, the scholarship funds will be held for a maximum of one additional year. At the end of the second year if the Scholarship Applicant is not accepted to an institution as required, the funds will be rescinded and becomes the property of the Heritage Foundation.

The scholarship will be paid in two installments over a one-year period with half of the amount paid at proof of enrollment to the institution and the second half at the beginning of the next grading period during that year.

Recipient must maintain a minimum 2.5 GPA to receive additional pro rata payments from the scholarship funds awarded. If the GPA falls below 2.5 the remaining amount of the scholarship is rescinded.

If any dispute arises between the scholarship recipient and the scholarship committee regarding and aspect of the scholarship, all parties agree to bring the dispute to the Heritage Foundation Board for discussion, a review, and a vote. A simple majority vote of the Board present on the issue will be final.

A copy of these guidelines and responsibilities will be provided to each applicant for the Heritage Hog Scholarship by the Selection Committee or its designee.
