### 4-H Council updates:

We had our first in-person meeting in over 1½ years! It was great to see everyone. We had quite a discussion on some topics. The 4-H council and membership approved the 4-H calendar (see below).

We also announced some changes to Sunrise breakfast for San Benito fair participants in 4-H & FFA. We are worried about the requirements for serving food during the fair with COVID. The Sunrise Breakfast committee presented a wonderful idea of dessert and donut breakfast. We will be sending out details in the near future on Sunrise Breakfast.

We are looking for a new I&R chairman as Danielle Nino has stepped down this year from this position. We would like to Thank Danielle for the many years of hard work as I & R chairman. If you are interested in this position please contact the 4-H office.

We received \$1,480 in donations this year on behalf of the John Ricotti scholarship. Carolina Ricotti passed away this year. The donations were made in her honor. We have renamed the John Ricotti memorial scholarship to John & Carolina Ricotti memorial scholarship. The scholarships will be given out in May to the 4-H high school seniors.

The 4-H council and membership voted to disperse excess funds from the 2020-2021 budget that were not used in last year's to various parties.

#### San Benito Fair:

The entry deadline for online entries for the fair is September 9th. Livestock youth will need to complete the YQCA training prior to completing livestock entries. Read the San Benito fair entry book for rules and requirements.

Dara Tobias will be posting fair updates on the San Benito Fair Facebook page. We are having a live show with livestock market animals, breeding, dairy goats, dairy cattle, rabbits, and poultry.

### Santa Cruz Fair: September 13th - 19th

The fair will only be open to the public from Wednesday to Sunday. We are being asked to wear a mask in the livestock area at all times to help the youth from the COVID virus. We will also have to wear masks inside the buildings.

New swine rule: No whips are allowed to be used during the swine show ring or sale ring. As a result of seeing an exhibitor beat the heck out of her hog with a whip at the 2019 fair, the fair staff has placed a new rule that hog whips will **NOT** be allowed in the swine show ring and sale ring. An exhibitor may use pig bats or crops, as well the old-school cane and PVC pipe. ### FIRST TIME 4-H YOUTH MEMBERSHIP (New 4-H membership)

- Paid within 30 days of registration =\$75
- If paid after 30 days of registration -see the payment schedule below for the month.

### RETURNING YOUTH MEMBER ENROLLMENT FEE (cash/check discount)

- Early Clover Special: July 1st September 30th = \$75
- Fall Clover: October 1st November 30th = \$85
- Late Clover: Enrollment: December 1st to June 30th = \$95

RETURNING YOUTH MEMBER ENROLLMENT FEES (with credit card processing fee)

- Early Clover Special: July 1st September 30th = \$85
- Fall Clover:: October 1st November 30th = \$95
- Late Clover: December 1st to June 30th = \$105

#### NEW & RETURNING ADULT LEADERS ENROLLMENT FEE:

- Cash/check discount = \$30.00
- Credit card payment = \$40.00
